- Participating **Group Training Companies** optimise various subsidies/incentives including ABBTF Brickstart to reduce the charge-out rate for hosts of brick and blocklaying apprentices.
- **CITB in South Australia** provide an upfront discount for bricklaying apprentice trade school fees up to \$400 per year, paid directly to the Endorsed Training Provider. Additional funding may also be available for Aboriginal Apprentice Support and Mentoring.
